NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim January 28, 1976 to be

MINNESOTA SCHOOL NURSE DAY

sponsored by the School Nurses Organization of Minnesota, associated with the Minnesota Education Association.
