



Proclamation

WHEREAS: nutrition is one of the most pervasive factors affecting the growth, development and health of an individual; and

WHEREAS: good nutrition has the potential to reduce cost of health services; and

WHEREAS: it is the right of every individual to be able to obtain sufficient knowledge to choose an adequate diet; and

WHEREAS: nutrition education programs in the schools would provide nutrition education for every school child; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is a leader in providing food for the nation and for the world; it should also be a leader in the provision of nutrition education for its people;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 12 and 13, 1976 as

MINNESOTA STATE NUTRITION EDUCATION DAYS

in conjunction with National Nutrition Week.
