- AS: the FFA motto, "Learning to do, doing to learn, learning to live, living to serve", gives direction and purpose to these future leaders for tomorrow's agriculture; and
- AS: their 1976 theme is "A Future For America -- FFA"; and
- AS: the FFA's main objectives are to provide supervised occupational experience programs in all phases of the agricultural complex; to emphasize the development of leadership, citizenship, personal improvement and occupational pride; and
- AS: this year marks the forty-sixth anniversary of the Minnesota Association of FFA, an organization composed of 16,124 active members who are studying agriculture/agribusiness/natural resources in 272 secondary schools; and
- AS: this training provides an excellent background for FFA members planning to enter production agriculture, agricultural college, area vocational technical schools or to pursue a challenging and rewarding career in agribusiness or natural resources;

HEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the week of February 21 - 28, 1976 as
