of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General II to the Department of Labor and Industry, and fix his compensation at the sum of Twenty Thousand, Six Hundred (\$20,600) Dollars per annum, to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of the Attorney General.

Said Special Assistant Attorney General II shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 7th day of January, 1976.



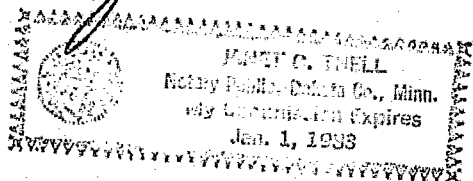
