

PETITION FOR ELECTION
FOR INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF BOCK
MILLE LACS COUNTY, MINNESOTA

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
THE COUNTY OF MILLE LACS AND STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1st. WE, The undersigned, electors and residents upon the land and within the territory hereinafter described and proposed to be incorporated as a village, respectfully petition your Honorable Board to appoint a time and place for holding an election, when and where the electors actually residing upon the lands hereinafter described, may vote for or against the incorporation of said territory as a village, to be known as VILLAGE OF BOCK.

2nd. That the territory to be incorporated as a village is all of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 14, Township 38, Range 26; the West half of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 14, Township 38, Range 26; all that part of the West half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) lying South of the Great Northern Railroad Right of Way in Section 14, Township 38, Range 26; all that part of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) lying South of the Great Northern Railroad Right of Way in Section 14, Township 38, Range 26; and that tract of land three hundred (300) feet in width owned and occupied by the Great Northern Railway Company as a Right of Way, passing through the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the West half of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 14, Township 38, Range 26, all in Mille Lacs County and State of Minnesota, and containing 98.20 acres, more or less, according to the Government Survey thereof.
