
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, do hereby constitute and appoint

of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Assistant Attorney General II to the Department of Labor and Industry, and fix his compensation at the sum of Twenty-Eight Thousand, Five Hundred (\$28,500) Dollars per annum to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of Labor and Industry.

Said Assistant Attorney General II shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 7th day of January, 1976.




