limited from time to time by the Superintendent of Banks.

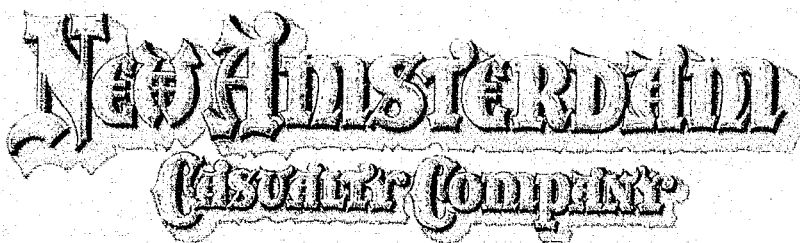
