
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WARREN SPANNAUS, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, do hereby constitute and appoint

CHRISTOPHER R. KELLEY

of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General I to the Department of the Attorney General, and fix his compensation at the sum of Fifteen Thousand, Six Hundred (\$15,600) Dollars per annum, three-fourths of which is to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of the Attorney General and one-fourth to be paid from the appropriations made for the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Commission.




