

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 76A

Amending Affirmative Action Program Procedures

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable Statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 76 created an Affirmative Action Program and an Equal Opportunity Executive Committee separate from the Department of Personnel, and

WHEREAS, the current state Personnel Act consolidates all personnel functions in the Department of Personnel.

NOW, THEREFORE, I order that Executive Order No. 76 is amended as follows:

- The Equal Opportunity Executive Committee created in paragraph 1 of Executive Order No. 76 is hereby abolished.
- The office of the State Director of Equal Opportunity as established in paragraph 2 of Executive Order No. 76 is hereby abolished.
- 3. All duties and functions relating to the Affirmative Action Program and to Equal Opportunity Programs are to be performed by the Commissioner of Personnel. If appropriate, the Commissioner shall issue Personnel Rules concerning this subject as provided by Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 43.

This Order shall be effective on the date of signature and shall remain in force concurrently with Executive Order No. 76.
