- REAS: the economic growth of residential, commercial and industrial development within the State are dependent upon the continuing supply of said well water; and
- REAS: it is of utmost importance that the people be aware of the outstanding progress made by the water-well industry which has been serving them throughout the years; and
- REAS: the Minnesota Water Well Association has designated the week of February 8-14 as a time to focus special attention on the water-well industry, their needs and the tasks which face them in the future; and
- REAS: the goal of the water-well industry is to continue to provide a service and quality of water that will fulfill the needs of the people of Minnesota;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim week of February 8-14, 1976 as
