



Proclamation

REAS: the United States Congress has enacted legislation which declares that it shall be the policy of the United States to become predominantly metric in weights and measures; and

REAS: the Minnesota Statutes contain legislation which provides for the gradual implementation and instruction concerning the metric system of weights and measures; and

REAS: the Minnesota Plan for Metric Education, developed by the Governor's Metric Advisory Council, calls for an implementation schedule tied to the date of federal enactment of legislation; and

REAS: the Minnesota State Board of Education has resolved that the Minnesota Plan for Metric Education be endorsed and implemented; and

REAS: the Minnesota Council of Teachers of Mathematics has been in the forefront of the process of implementing metric education in the schools of Minnesota;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim month of March, 1976 to be

METRIC EDUCATION MONTH

Minnesota, and encourage the Minnesota Council of Teachers of Mathematics and the Minnesota Department of Education to schedule appropriate activities in keeping with the proclamation.
