


Section 2. Territory annexed:


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.



ORDINANCE NO. 200

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LONG PRAIRIE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LAND ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, the City of Long Prairie gave notice of its intention to annex the territory hereinafter described and which duly presented to the Council on 2nd day of June, 1975, and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced with the area described in the petition and bounded as described is less than two hundred (200) acres of unplatted land, being approximately 5 acres, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough, and

WHEREAS, the property is completely surrounded by property in the city limits of Long Prairie, and

WHEREAS, no objection to the annexation has been received from the owners, town board, the county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the land to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, a copy of said Notice to Annex was filed with the Town Clerk of Long Prairie Township, and sixty (60) days have lapsed since the filing and no objections have been filed by the Township or the owners, and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the city limits on four sides thereof:

The Council of the City of Long Prairie, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines:

- (a) That the annexation will be to the best interests of the City, and of the territory affected.
- (b) That the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is urban or suburban in character.
- (c) That none of the territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough
