

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LOTS AND BLOCKS TO THE VILLAGE OF AMBOY. # 35

The Village Council of the Village of Amboy do ordain as follows:

Section I.

THAT WHEREAS a petition of a majority of the owners of the property in Brush's Addition to the Village of Amboy described as follows:- Lots numbered one to five (1-5) inclusive in Block numbered one (1), and Lots numbered one to ten (1-10) inclusive in Block numbered two (2) of Brush's Addition to the Village of Amboy, Minnesota, according to the recorded plat of said Addition in the Office of the Register of Deeds of said Blue Earth County, Minnesota, together with all streets and alleys as the same appear in said plat of said Brush's Addition to the Village of Amboy; has been duly filed with the Village Clerk to annex the lands above described in the Village of Amboy.

NOW THEREFORE the following described land viz:- Lots numbered one to five (1-5) inclusive in Block numbered one (1), and Lots numbered one to ten (1-10) inclusive in Block numbered two (2) of Brush's Addition to the Village of Amboy, Minnesota, according to the recorded plat of said Addition in the Office of the Register of Deeds of said Blue Earth County, Minnesota, together with all streets and alleys as the same appear in said plat of said Brush's Addition to the Village of Amboy, are hereby annexed to said Village and the same are a part of said Village as effectually as if they had been a part thereof.

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior

to the date of the first publication of said.....

Ordinance.....the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said county of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921.
