



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the Red School House, Inc. is a non-profit school located at 643 Virginia Avenue, Saint Paul; and

WHEREAS: the Red School House, Inc. represents a viable and contributing presence in the Saint Paul community through its school programs for Native American students of all ages who desire a culturally based educational opportunity; and

WHEREAS: the Red School House, Inc. now finds that it must seek funding and broader community support for its curriculum and Native American youth programs; and

WHEREAS: native and non-native community supporters have joined in a Native American Walk for Survival in support of the school;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the day of February 28, 1976 as

"NATIVE AMERICAN WALK FOR SURVIVAL DAY"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to observe and appreciate the efforts of the dedicated participants.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this eighteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-six and of the State the one hundred eighteenth.
