



Proclamation

- REAS: the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries will hold its Thirteenth Annual Convention on May 1, 1976; and
- REAS: all of the members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries solemnly bind themselves under their Code of Ethics to maintain the highest standards in their contacts with Government, Courts, law offices, clients, and any and all persons; and
- REAS: the efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is of first importance to Government, the Courts, and to attorneys and their clients; and
- REAS: one of the aims and purposes of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries is to further the education of its members and to increase their knowledge of the law; and
- REAS: it is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the Government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and appreciate the safeguards to our liberty
provided by our government of laws and by the orderly process of our courts.
