

Proclamation

REAS: the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries will hold its Thirteenth Annual Convention on May 1, 1976; and

REAS: all of the members of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries solemnly bind themselves under their Code of Ethics to maintain the highest standards in their contacts with Government, Courts, law offices, clients, and any and all persons; and

REAS: the efficiency of the professional services of legal secretaries is of first importance to Government, the Courts, and to attorneys and their clients; and

REAS: one of the aims and purposes of the Minnesota Association of Legal Secretaries is to further the education of its members and to increase their knowledge of the law; and

REAS: it is in the public interest that legal secretaries have the opportunity to observe the Government with which they are so closely associated by reason of their profession as legal secretaries:

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim 1, 1976 as
