



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the National Mothers of Twins Club was organized in Canton, Ohio in 1960; and

WHEREAS: the purpose of MOTC is to broaden the understanding of those aspects of child development and rearing which relate to twins; and

WHEREAS: this is accomplished through interchange of information among parents, educators, doctors, and others with a direct interest and appropriate experience; and

WHEREAS: there are now 224 member clubs in 44 states representing more than 8,000 members; and

WHEREAS: there are six Mothers of Twins Clubs in the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: the St. Paul Minnesota Mothers of Twins Club is sponsoring the state's second workshop in St. Paul on April 24, 1976;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 24, 1976 to be

MOTHERS OF TWINS DAY

in Minnesota.
