



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *ORT (Organization for Rehabilitation through Training) has, for the past 96 years, as the vocational education program of the Jewish people, dedicated itself to the building of individuals and of entire societies through its world-wide network of vocational education and training in schools; and*

WHEREAS: *ORT is engaged in striving toward the establishment of an operational presence on the American scene; and*

WHEREAS: *Women's American ORT is increasing its efforts to advance the cause of vocational education in the United States and to elevate the caliber and stature of vocational and career education in this country; and*

WHEREAS: *Women's American ORT, the largest group in the world supporting the ORT program, has undertaken the vigorous task of expanding the vital facilities of ORT-ISRAEL;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim March 17, 1976 to be

ORT DAY

in Minnesota in recognition of the vital achievements of Women's American ORT.
