WHEREAS: for 50 years the Minneapolis Urban League has provided continuous services to the minority and disadvantaged citizens of Minneapolis; and

WHEREAS: its program efforts in the area of human relations and community concerns have benefited untold thousands of Minnesotans during this period; and

WHEREAS: now more than ever before community service agencies such as the Minneapolis Urban League should be encouraged and supported; and

WHEREAS: to commemorate 50 years of service to the community, the Board of Directors and staff have planned a Golden Anniversary dinner to be held on April 8, 1976;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, April 8, 1976 to be

MINNEAPOLIS URBAN LEAGUE DAY

and urge all citizens to observe this notable occasion, and pay tribute to the outstanding achievements of the Urban League which have enriched the State of Minnesota.
