Effective April 9, 1976
Pursuant to authority vested in me by law, I, Robert L. Herbst, Commissioner of Natural Resources, do hereby establish the following fees and charges for State Park Facilities and republish herein the Fort Shelling Chapel Rental Fee Schedule established by the Commissioner of Administration pursuant to Laws of Minnesota 1974, Chapter 355, Sec. 44, Effective July 31, 1974. All previous orders establishing fees and charges are hereby rescinded and superceded by this order.
