

of Bloomington, Minnesota, as Investigator II to the Department of the Attorney General, and fix his compensation at the sum of Eighteen Thousand (\$18,000) per annum, to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of the Attorney General.

Said Investigator II shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 15th day of March, 1976.




