

SUBJECT: Appointment of Kent W. Larson as Special Counsel



I would like to request the appointment of Kent W. Larson as Special Counsel to assist the Division of Minerals in the review and processing of a number of particularly involved copper-nickel lease assignments, taconite conversion agreement, and to initiate a review of world mining laws.

Due to the amount of staff time that the Department of Natural Resources and the Division of Minerals in particular has had to expend on the Reserve hearings, a considerable backlog of mineral-related matters has developed. It is necessary, therefore, that a special effort must be made to attend to the above-listed items.

For your convenience I am enclosing a copy of Mr. Larson's resume'. It would be particularly helpful if he could be appointed as Special Counsel for a 60-day period, beginning February 27, 1976.


TERMINATION OF APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL ATTORNEY
