
Dear Governor Wendell R. Anderson,

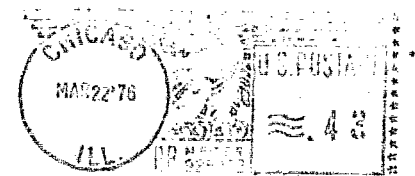

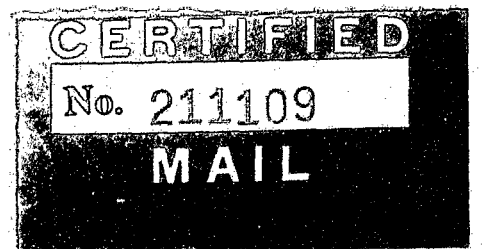


Excellency:
