AN ORDINANCE
CREATING & ESTABLISHING A SEWER DISTRICT
FOR THE
VILLAGE OF AMBOY, BLUE EARTH COUNTY
MINNESOTA

The Village Council of the Village of Amboy, Blue Earth Co., Minnesota,

DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That a Sewer District #2 is hereby created and established within and for the Village of Amboy, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, upon and including the territory in the said Village within the boundaries for said district as hereinafter specified:

The limits and boundaries of said sewer district #2 shall be and are hereby established as follows:

Bounded by a line beginning at the north line of First alley north of Pleasant Ave. and the east line of Fourth Ave., thence east along the north line of said alley to the east line of first alley east of Fourth Ave., thence south along the east line of said alley to the quarter section line of Sec. 23, thence west along said quarter section line to the west line of Fourth Ave., thence north along the west line of Fourth Ave. to the boundary of Sewer Dist. #1, thence east along said boundary to the east boundary of Sewer Dist. #1, thence northerly to the place of beginning.

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same.

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior

to the date of the first publication of said.....

..... the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county auditor of said county of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws Minnesota, 1921.

That the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisement hereunto attached, viz:
