


Dear Madam:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Counties of Cass and Hubbard comprise a County Court District under Section 487.01, Subdivision 5, Minn. Stat., which at the present time has one full-time County Judge not learned in the law, and a part-time Judicial Officer learned in the law, and

WHEREAS the business of the County Courts of Cass and Hubbard Counties requires two full-time County Judges,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Section 487.01, Subdivision 5 (5), by the concurring Boards of Commissioners of Cass and Hubbard Counties, that:

1. That beginning June 1, 1976, two full-time County Judges be employed, they being the Honorable Keith Kraft, with chambers at Park Rapids, Minnesota, and another full-time County Judge learned in the law, to be appointed according to law prior to June 1, 1976, and to have chambers at Walker, Minnesota.
2. That at all times the Judge with chambers at Park Rapids, Minnesota shall be a full-time resident of Hubbard County, and the Judge with chambers at Walker, Minnesota shall be a full-time resident of Cass County.
3. That all costs of the County Court operations be prorated as in the past between the two counties involved according to the latest official population census for said counties.
4. That the above Resolution shall be effective March 2, 1976.


