



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Farm Worker Week is sponsored by the National Farm Worker Ministry, the National Council of Churches, the National Catholic Conference and the Synagogue Council of America; and

WHEREAS: May 2 - 8, 1976 has been set aside for reflection of the historical plight and present status of seasonal farm workers; and

WHEREAS: farm workers are seeking to lift themselves from helpless poverty and affirm their dignity as human beings through collective bargaining;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 2 - 8, 1976 as

FARM WORKER WEEK

in Minnesota and all citizens are encouraged to increase their awareness of the present plight and future aspirations of seasonal farm workers both in Minnesota and throughout the United States.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this nineteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-six and of the State the one hundred eighteenth.
