



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the Minnesota Business Educators, Incorporated, is sponsoring a Business Education Conference in Rochester on May 7 and 8; and*

WHEREAS: *the theme of this convention is "Business Education: Meeting Tomorrow's Challenge Today!"; and*

WHEREAS: *the observance of this Business Education Conference, in cooperation with teachers and educational training institutions on all levels, is to give emphasis to the fact that business education requires an orientation toward dealing with people, an ability to perform in an integrated environment, a high degree of competency in communication skills, and an outstanding and dedicated effort to meet tomorrow's challenges today; and*

WHEREAS: *the observance of Business Education Week will be climaxed at the tenth annual spring conference of the Minnesota Business Educators, Incorporated, in the Kahler Hotel in Rochester on May 7 and 8, 1976, in honor of instructors, administrators, exhibitors and representatives of business organizations sponsoring this event;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 2 - 8, 1976, to be

"MINNESOTA BUSINESS EDUCATION WEEK"

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to take cognizance of this time.
