The undersigned respectfully set forth to your honorable body the following facts:

that they and each of them are legal voters residing within the following described territory situated in the County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, to-wit:

The Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Thirty-four (34), the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Thirty-five (35), all the West Half (W 1/2) of Section Twenty-six (26), all of said described land being situated in Township Sixty-three (63) North, Range Twelve (12), West of the 4th P.M.

That the boundaries of said territory are as follows:

At a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Ely, St. Louis County, Minnesota, held March 20, 1923, in the City Hall of said City.

Alderman Hunter offered the following resolution and moved its adoption, which motion to adopt was seconded by Alderman Juddich.

Whereas a petition for calling an election for the determination of the proposed annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the City of Ely, St. Louis County, Minnesota has been presented to the Council of said City of Ely this 20th day of March, 1923, and it appearing that said petition has been properly signed by not less than five legal voters residing within the territory therein proposed to be annexed to said City of Ely, and

Whereas it appears by said petition that a census of the resident population of said territory had first been duly taken within four weeks of the date of the presentation of said petition to this Council; that said territory appears by said census to have a resident population of not less than 75 persons, that the number of actual residents thereon is 224 persons; that the description of said territory so sought to be annexed is as follows: The Northeast Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section Thirty-four (34), the Northwest Quarter (NW 1/4) of Section Thirty-five (35), and the West Half (W 1/2) of Section Twenty-six (26), all of said described land being situated in Township Sixty-three (63) North, Range Twelve (12) West of the 4th P.M., situate within St. Louis County, Minnesota; that the boundaries of said territory so sought to be annexed are as follows: Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Section 34; thence running westerly along the North line of said Section 34 to the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of said Section 34; thence running southerly along the North and South center line of said Section 34 to the Southwest corner of the Northeast quarter of said Section 34; thence running easterly along the East and West center line of said Section 34 and the East and West center line of said Section 35 to the Southeast corner of the Northwest quarter of said Section 35; thence running northerly along the North and South center line of said Section 35; and the North and South center line of said Section 26 to the Northeast corner of the Northwest quarter of said Section 26; thence running westerly along the Northernly line of said Section 26 to the shore line of Long Lake; thence southwesterly along the shore line of Long Lake, by its various courses and distances, to its intersection with the Westerly

Be It Further Resolved that John Gildion, Mary Fafner and Eli Jonnes, residents of said territory are hereby appointed inspectors who shall act as judges of said election and shall conduct the same so far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of town officers, and

Be It Further Resolved, that due and legal notice of said election shall be given by the City Clerk of the City of Ely according to law, and copies of said petition, together with the notice of said election fixing the time and place for holding the same, be posted in three public places within such territory.
