



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the intent of "All American Mutt Day" is to instill in dog owners a sense of responsibility for both the safety and actions of their pets; and

WHEREAS: participants in "All American Mutt Day" must have their dog properly licensed and leashed in accord with the ordinances of the City of St. Paul and/or their respective Minnesota communities; and

WHEREAS: every participating pet owner will be urged to have their pet spayed or neutered so as not to add to the appalling pet population explosion; and

WHEREAS: each participant will be given a discount contract to have the necessary surgery performed by a cooperating veterinarian;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 5, 1976, to be

ALL AMERICAN MUTT DAY

in Minnesota.
