



Proclamation

WHEREAS: more than 200,000 Minnesotans live in mobile homes; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has become a major manufacturer of mobile homes for the Upper Midwest; and

WHEREAS: the mobile home industry is clearly an important segment of our life and economy in Minnesota constituting a free enterprise answer to the need for non-subsidized low-income housing; and

WHEREAS: mobile home occupants comprise a section of all vocations, including students of higher learning, doctors, attorneys, executives, skilled and unskilled workers, and senior citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 2 through 9, 1976 to be

MOBILE HOME WEEK '76

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to mark its celebration.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this nineteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-six and of the State the one hundred eighteenth.
