WHEREAS: tennis is an active, exciting game which can be enjoyed by players of all ages, skill levels, and economic backgrounds; and

WHEREAS: tennis is the nation's fastest growing sport and one of the most valuable means of maintaining personal fitness; and

WHEREAS: National Tennis Week is a nationwide event which is being conducted by Tennis Magazine and has been acknowledged by the President's Council on Physical Fitness and Sports, the United States Professional Tennis Association, the National Indoor Tennis Association, the Tennis Foundation of North America, the United States Tennis Association, and the U. S. Tennis Court and Track Builders Association; and

WHEREAS: tennis players of all ages and skills will have the opportunity to receive free tennis instruction given by U.S.P.T.A. members on National Clinic Day, June 19;
