WHEREAS: there is a need to focus attention on methods of improving administrative work; and

WHEREAS: the leaders of government, business and education are concerned with this need; and

WHEREAS: improvement can be made through the use of new techniques and automated equipment; and

WHEREAS: the participation of these leaders and their staffs in educational programs, seminars and exhibitions of new methods and equipment will enhance their capabilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 9 through May 15, 1976 as

OFFICE IMPROVEMENT WEEK

in Minnesota, and call upon those professional societies, dedicated to better business management to join with the Word Processing Association of Minnesota in bringing about an overall improvement in offices throughout the State of Minnesota in 1976.
