



Proclamation

- HEREAS: Sgt. Robert Tyson was a member of the Edina Police Department from February 1, 1971 to December 31, 1973; and
- HEREAS: he joined the Eden Prairie Public Safety Department on January 1, 1974 and has demonstrated outstanding ability in the development and implementation of police, community relations and police-school liaison programs; and
- HEREAS: mutual affection and trust exist between him and Eden Prairie students, who call him "Officer Bob"; and
- HEREAS: Bob Tyson's personal involvement in a situation -- whether a classroom presentation or a family crisis that calls for tact and sensitivity -- is only one of the qualities that makes him a superior police officer; and
- HEREAS: Sgt. Robert Tyson's professionalism, commitment, and competence have gained him the respect and esteem of parents, the clergy, and school, city and juvenile court officials; and
- HEREAS: a school principal expressed the community's feeling for Bob Tyson when he wrote: "Eden Prairie's future is all the brighter due to this officer's fine work"; and
- HEREAS: Minnesota's Chiefs of Police Association has selected Sgt. Tyson as the recipient of the Police Officer of the Year Award; and
- HEREAS: he is being honored at a banquet and appropriate ceremonies on Wednesday, April 14;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, April 14, 1976 to be

in Minnesota, and extend to him my congratulations and admiration on behalf of the people of Minnesota
