MEREAS: its presence supplied frontier families with an important source of food during

Minnesota's early years as a state; and

HEREAS: its unique characteristics make it an object of extreme interest to both wildlife

specialists and the general public; and

intensive cultivation has reduced the prairie chicken's habitat in Minnesota to

a small, but vitally important, segment of its original range; and

EREAS: the City of Rothsay, Minnesota, is located in the heart of the state's remaining

prairie chicken habitat; and

TEREAS: the conservation-minded people of Rothsay have expressed their desire to preserve

remaining tracts of prairie chicken habitat and have shown pride in being the center of the bird's range;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim e City of Rothsay to be the

PRAIRIE CHICKEN CAPITAL

Hinnesota.
