**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
THE CHARTER OF THE CITY  
OF ANOKA, MINN.**

FRAMED AND ADOPTED PURSUANT  
TO SECTION 38 OF ARTICLE 4 OF  
THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE  
OF MINNESOTA, AND SECTIONS 748  
TO 758, INCLUSIVE, REVISED LAWS  
OF 1905, AND THE ACTS SUPPLE-  
MENTAL THERETO AND AMENDA-  
TORY THEREOF.

**AMENDMENT NUMBER ONE**  
That Section 2, Chapter VI of the City  
Charter be amended so as to read as fol-  
lows:

**Examination of Books, Reports, Etc.,  
of Officers and Employees.**  
Section 2. The Commission shall  
employ, once a year, either the State  
Public Examiner or some other com-  
petent accountant to be paid by the  
City, who shall have full power to  
examine all books, records and re-  
ports of all officers and employees  
who receive or disburse city moneys,  
and the books, records and reports of  
such other officers and departments  
as the Mayor or the Commission may  
direct. Said accountant may require  
any officer or employee to be sworn  
and explain under oath all matters  
relative to said books, records and re-  
ports. All officers and employees of  
the city shall give to such accountant  
all required assistance and informa-  
tion, under oath or otherwise, as to  
all matters relating to such books,  
records and reports, and shall submit  
to him for examination such books  
and papers as may be requested. Re-  
fusal or failure of any officer or em-  
ployee of the city to comply with the  
requirements of this section shall be  
sufficient ground for his removal from  
such office or employment.

amendment was duly submitted.
