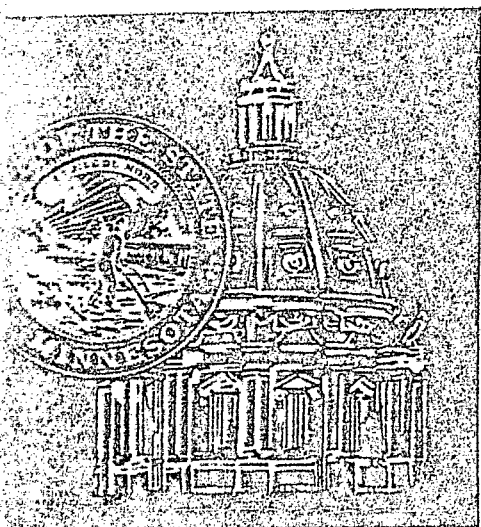


State of Minnesota



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: home economics is the field of knowledge and service primarily concerned with strengthening family life; and
- WHEREAS: home economists are active in business, education, communications, research and legislation, and in health, welfare and ecological programs; and
- WHEREAS: through their professional skills, home economists improve our living standards and the quality of family life; and
- WHEREAS: the American Home Economics Association, an educational and scientific organization founded in 1909, is among the 20 largest professional organizations in the United States with a membership of more than 53,000 men and women; and
- WHEREAS: the Minnesota Home Economics Association, one of 52 affiliates of AHEA, has a membership of 2,000; and
- WHEREAS: "Our Professional Heritage, Quality of Life and Public Policy" is the theme of the 67th Annual Meeting of the American Home Economics Association, which will convene in Minneapolis the week beginning June 28;

AND, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of June 28 - July 2, 1976 to be
