

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
UNINCORPORATED LAND TO THE CITY OF HANCOCK

THE CITY OF HANCOCK DOES ORDAIN:

ORDINANCE NO. 60

Subdivision 1. Annexation by Ordinance: The City of Hancock does hereby annex to the City of Hancock certain unincorporated land abutting the City of Hancock and not included in any other municipality, situated in the County of Stevens, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Northwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Twenty-three (123), Range Forty-one (41) West, lying and being on the north side of the right of way of the Great Northern Railway Company's road bed and tracks and described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the northwest corner of said Southwest Quarter of said Section Two, Township and Range as aforesaid, thence running east on the quarter line a distance of 60.97 rods, thence running due south to the northern boundary of the right of way of said Great Northern Railway Company, a distance of 56.75 rods, thence northwesterly along the North boundary of said Railway Company's right of way a distance of 80 rods, 11 feet, and 4 inches to the place of beginning, containing 10.8 acres inclusive of highways and 10 acres, exclusive of highways, more or less, according to said measurements, according to the Plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said Stevens County.

A tract of land lying and being in the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Two (2), Township One Hundred Twenty-three (123) North, Range Forty-one (41) West, described by metes and bounds as follows: The point of beginning being a point which is 50 feet due north and 350.5 feet due east of the Southwest corner of said Northwest Quarter of Section Two, Township One Hundred Twenty-three North, Range Forty-one West, said point being on the north right of way line of County Road No. 8. Thence continuing due east and parallel with the South line of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 123 North, Range 41 West, a distance of 984.5 feet; thence by an angle right of 90 degrees a distance of 621.2 feet to the southwest right of way line of Trunk Highway No. 9; thence by an angle left of 28 degrees 08 minutes in a northwesterly direction along the southwesterly right of way line of T.H. #9 a distance of 525.4 feet; thence by an angle left of 62 degrees 14 minutes in a westerly direction along the south boundary of East View Addition to the Village of Hancock a distance of 1066 feet, this point being on the west line of Section 2; thence due South along the west line of said Section 2 a distance of 652.2 feet; thence by an angle left of 44 degrees 43 minutes in a southeasterly direction a distance of 344.7 feet; thence by an angle right of 13 degrees 03 minutes a distance of 205.1 feet to the point of beginning and there terminating. Said tract of land containing 29.46 acres more or less.

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This annexation shall be final upon the passage and publication of this Ordinance according to law, and upon filing a copy of the Ordinance with the Municipal Commission, the Moore Township Clerk, the Stevens County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, State of Minnesota.
