- REAS: Rabbi Louis Milgrom has been the Director of the B'nai B'rith Hillel Foundation at the University of Minnesota for 27 years; and
- REAS: in that capacity Rabbi Milgrom over the years has served as a teacher in the broadest and highest sense of that word; and
- REAS: he has personified and exemplified the highest ideals of Judaism in his daily living and in the performance of his duties as Director of the Hillel Foundation; and
- REAS: Rabbi Milgrom has imparted to thousands of Jewish students the customs, traditions, and ethical values of Judaism; and
- REAS: he has counseled countless numbers of students on personal matters; and
- REAS: he has brought to the University for the benefit and enlightenment of persons of all faiths eminent Jewish scholars and theologians; and
- REAS: Rabbi Milgrom has fostered and implemented the spirit of ecumenicism among the various religious foundations at the University of Minnesota; and
- REAS: Rabbi Milgrom is retiring as Director of the B'nai B'rith Hillel Foundation;
