Wheneas, Section 447.31 to 447.37 of Minnesota Statutes authorizes the creation and operation of a hospital district comprising the territory of four or more designated (ities, Villages, or Towns for the purpose of the acquisition, betterment, operation, maintenance, and administration of a hospital and nursing home; and,
