the following administrative reorganization is made.

The authority of the Office of Hearings Examiner to hold hearings  
on contested cases in which an applicant, recipient, or county is  
entitled by law to a fair hearing before the state relative to the  
programs of Aid to Families with Dependent Children, Medical Assis-  
tance, Food Stamps, General Relief Medical, General Assistance and  
Minnesota Supplemental Aid is hereby transferred to the Department  
of Public Welfare.

This transfer only affects those requests for a hearing filed  
before May 1, 1976.

It has been determined that there are no appropriation dollars  
required to be transferred because of the transfer of this function.

This order is effective January 1, 1976.
