- WHEREAS: forty-six member congregations of the American Lutheran Church form the basis of Ebenezer Society in the church community; and
- WHEREAS: Ebenezer Society is one of the largest geriatric complexes in the country, serving nearly 800 elderly people within its facilities and nearly 2,000 more through outreach programs in the Twin Cities metropolitan community; and
- WHEREAS: Ebenezer Society is recreating happy memories for residents whose early lives were spent in a rural environment, through sight, touch, sound and smell of farm animals on June 5, 1976; and
- WHEREAS: this event is made possible through the cooperation and assistance of the young men and women of the Chaska Chapter of F.F.A.;
