



Proclamation

WHEREAS: *the St. Vasilije of Ostrog Serbian Eastern Orthodox Church of Chisholm, Minnesota is holding its 29th Annual Serbian Days; and*

WHEREAS: *the St. Vasilije of Ostrog Serbian Church is celebrating its 66th Anniversary, and serves the spiritual needs of the Serbian community in the State of Minnesota until 1923 when additional churches came into existence; and*

WHEREAS: *in order to meet the social and cultural needs of the Serbian community, a magnificent school hall was built in 1964; and*

WHEREAS: *the St. Vasilije of Ostrog Serbian Orthodox Church of Chisholm was rejuvenated by building a new house of worship, a new parish home and a church office which were consecrated during the Serbian Days celebration, July 1973; and*

WHEREAS: *those of Serbian nationality have given to this State their hearts, hands and minds in developing its great natural resources and with their sons and daughters defended the freedom of the State and Nation;*

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 10th and 11th, 1976 as

SERBIAN DAYS

and urge all Minnesotans to join with their fellow citizens in celebrating this important occasion.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-six and of the State the one hundred eighteenth.
