REAS: our system of justice plays a vital role in the life of our citizens; and

REAS: the administration of justice requires discretion, compassion and objectivity; and

REAS: Judge Clarence A. Rolloff has exemplified these qualities in the thirty years he has served as Chief Judge, Eighth Judicial District; and

REAS: Judge Rolloff was admitted to the bar in 1929 following his graduation from the University of Minnesota Law School in 1929; and

REAS: Judge Rolloff served as Chippewa County Attorney for twelve years, from 1931 to 1946, and practiced law in Montivideo for seventeen years; and

REAS: he is a former President and recent Case Editor of the Minnesota Law Review, served as Secretary and Vice President of the Minnesota County Attorneys' Association, and as President and Secretary of the Twelfth Judicial Bar Association; and

REAS: Judge Rolloff's dedication to the cause of justice, his long commitment to good citizenship and participation in civic endeavors are being recognized at a retirement party on this day;
