ORDINANCE NO. 72

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, MINNESOTA, DECLARING THE WARD TO WHICH IT SHALL BE ATTACHED AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS TO ENCOMPASS SAID LAND.

WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria is the owner of certain land lying in the County of Douglas and State of Minnesota, described as follows:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Twenty-eight (128), Range Thirty-eight (38) West lying east of the following described line: Commencing at a point on the South section line of Section 13 of Township 128, Range 38, 691.6 feet East of the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 13; running thence North 1318.02 feet more or less to the north line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$).

and,

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alexandria has leased the certain real estate to the Douglas County Agricultural Association by that certain lease dated December 31, 1969, for a period of 66 years to expire December 31, 2035, for the purpose of use by the Lessee for public purposes but not limited to fairs, sporting events and exhibitions, and

WHEREAS, the Lessee, Douglas County Agricultural Association has indicated a desire that such land be annexed to the City of Alexandria and that the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria be altered to include said property, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alexandria has reviewed the facts and circumstances and found that it is desirable to have the said property annexed and has further found that said property is contiguous to the existing boundaries of the City of Alexandria and that the said land is agricultural and contains no population, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alexandria finds that the property set forth above is so conditioned as to properly be subject to municipal government and further that the governing body of the City of Alexandria finds that the annexation of said property will be in the best interests of the municipality, and the territory

affected and to be annexed,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Alexandria
does ORDAIN:

SECTION I The following described land, to-wit:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 13, Township One Hundred Twenty-eight (128), Range Thirty-eight (38) West, lying East of the following described line: Commencing at a point on the South section line of Section 13 of Township 128, Range 38, 691.6 feet East of the Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section 13; running thence North 1318.02 feet more or less to the north line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$).

is hereby annexed to and made a part of the municipality of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, and the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, shall be and hereby are, extended to include and encompass the land and territory above described.

SECTION II All of the land and territory described in Section I above and hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, shall be and does hereby become a part of the Fifth Ward of the City of Alexandria.



PRINTER'S AFFIDAVIT OF PUBLICATION

(3) Said newspaper has 50% of its news columns devoted to news of local interest to the community which it purports to serve and does not wholly duplicate any other publication and is not made up entirely of patents, plate matter and advertisements. (4) Said newspaper is circulated in and near the municipality which it purports to serve, has at least 500 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, has an average of at least 75% of its total circulation currently paid or no more than three months in arrears and has entry as second-class matter in its local post-office. (5) Said newspaper purports to serve the City of Alexandria in the County of Douglas and it has its known office of issue in the City of Alexandria in said county, established and open during its regular business hours for the gathering of news, sale of advertisements and sale of subscriptions and maintained by the managing officer of said newspaper or persons in its employ and subject to his direction and control during all such regular business hours and at which said newspaper is printed. (6) Said newspaper files a copy of each issue immediately with the State Historical Society. (7) Said newspaper has complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least two years preceding the day or dates of publication mentioned below. (8) Said newspaper has filed with the Secretary of State of Minnesota prior to January 1, 1966 and each January 1 thereafter an affidavit in the form prescribed by the secretary of State and signed by the managing officer of said newspaper and sworn to before a notary public stating that the newspaper is a legal newspaper.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE TO THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA, MINNESOTA, AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS TO ENCOMPASS SAID LAND.
WHEREAS, the City of Alexandria is the owner of certain real estate lying in the County of Douglas and State of Minnesota, described as follows:
All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Twenty-eight (128), Range Thirty-eight (38) West, lying East of the following described line: Commencing at a point on the South Section line of Section 13 of Township 128, Range 38, 691.0 feet East of the Southeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) of said Section 13; running thence North 1318.02 feet more or less to the north line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), and
WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alexandria has leased the certain real estate to the Douglas County Agricultural Association by that certain lease dated December 31, 1969, for a period of 69 years to expire December 31, 2038, for the purpose of use by the Lessee for public purposes but not limited to fairs, sporting events and exhibitions, and
WHEREAS, the Lessee, Douglas County Agricultural Association has indicated a desire that such land be annexed to the City of Alexandria and that the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria be altered to include said property, and
WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alexandria has reviewed the facts and circumstances and found that it is desirable to have the said property annexed and has further found that said property is contiguous to the existing boundaries of the City of Alexandria and that the said land is agricultural and contains no population, and
WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Alexandria finds that the property heretofore above is so conditioned as to property as subject to municipal government and further that the governing body of the City of Alexandria finds that the annexation of said property will be in the best interests of the municipality, and the territory affected and to be annexed,
NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Alexandria does ORDAIN:
SECTION 1. The following described land, to-wit:
All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), Section Thirteen (13), Township One Hundred Twenty-eight (128), Range Thirty-eight (38) West, lying East of the following described line: Commencing at a point on the South section line of Section 13 of Township 128, Range 38, 691.0 feet East of the Southeast Corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 SW 1/4) of said Section 13; running thence North 1318.02 feet more or less to the north line of the said Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW 1/4 SE 1/4), is hereby annexed to and made a part of the municipality of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, and the corporate limits of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, shall be and hereby are extended to include and encompass the land and territory above described.
SECTION 2. All of the land and territory described in Section 1 above and hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Alexandria, Minnesota, shall be and does hereby become a part of the Fifth Ward of the City of Alexandria.
Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of Minnesota, the Charter of the City of Alexandria, upon the filing of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the La Grand Township Clerk, the County Auditor of Douglas County, Minnesota, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
