ORDINANCE NO. 618

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN PROPERTIES CONTAINED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OWATONNA DO ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The Sacred Heart Cemetery is wholly enclosed by the City of Owatonna, and is suitably conditioned for and needs urban government, and

Said Sacred Heart Cemetery is not now included in any other municipality nor is it subject to any other proceeding for annexation, incorporation or consolidation.

SECTION 2. Said Sacred Heart Cemetery is wholly owned by the Sacred Heart Cemetery Association of Winona and the Diocese of Winona, and said owners have asked that the cemetery, in its entirety, be annexed to and made a part of the City of Owatonna.

SECTION 3. Said Sacred Heart Cemetery is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Owatonna and the corporate limits of said City are hereby altered to include the aforesaid Sacred Heart Cemetery, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

> The East fifteen (15) acres of the North Half of Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter $(N_{\overline{2}}^{1} \text{ of } SE_{\overline{4}}^{1} \text{ of } NE_{\overline{4}}^{1})$ of Section twenty-one (21), Township one hundred and seven (107) North of Range twenty (20) West,

> > and

Commencing at a point in the East line of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter $(NW_4^1 \text{ of } SE_4^1 \text{ of } NE_4^1)$ of Section twenty-one (21), Township one hundred and seven (107) North, of Range twenty (20) West, one hundred and ninetyseven and eight-tenths (197.8) feet North of the Southeast Corner of the above described tract, thence North along said line four hundred and seventy-one and nine-tenths (471.9) feet; thence West along the North line of said tract two hundred and sixtythree (263) feet; thence South, parallel to the East line of said tract, four hundred (400) feet; thence in a Southeasterly direction two hundred and seventy-three (273) feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 414, Section 414.033, Subdivision 4.
