



WHEREAS: Nurse Anesthetists who serve in many of our Minnesota hospitals play an important role providing efficient and modern health care to our citizens; and

CHEREAS: more than fifty percent of all anesthesia today is administered by Nurse Anesthetists;

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Association of Nurse Anesthetists, which has 565 members, provides leader in continuing education for certified registered nurse anesthetists; and

WHEREAS: there are nine schools of anesthesia in Minnesota with a total enrollment of 120 studen: and

WHEPFAS: the Minnosota Association of Nurse Anesthetists is affliciated with the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists which has a membership of more than 16,000; and

WHEREAS: the object of this Association is to facilitate cooperation between the Nurse Anesthetic and the medical profession, hospitals and other agencies interested in anesthesia;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim July 18-24, 1976 as

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens to join in appropriate observance of this event, which coincides with the organization's summer meeting on July 16, 17, and 18.
