HEREAS: July 4th is America's favorite holiday and boating is becoming America's favorite form of family recreation within our state and throughout the nation; and

there is a growing need to know and observe safe boating rules and regulations and to provide for the safety of other boaters, as well as ourselves by becoming equipped with boating safety knowledge; and

the Congress, by joint resolution approved June 4, 1958 (72 Stat. 179), has requested the President to proclaim annually the week which includes July 4, as National Safe Boating Week;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, join with the Governors to States, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, Guam and America Samoa, and Commissioner of the District of Columbia in proclaiming the week beginning July 4, 1976 as
