

Proclamation

- REASONS: grandmothers play a significant role in the lives of Americans of all ages, instilling in their children and their children's children the values that have made this country strong; and
- REASONS: those who have enjoyed the affection, kind attention and words of wisdom only grandmothers can impart, realize the contributions they have made; and
- REASONS: the Minneapolis National Grandmothers' Club, Chapter 8, was organized in 1940, and is affiliated with the National Federation of Grandmother Clubs of America; and
- REASONS: member clubs will convene in Dayton, Ohio, from October 9 through October 14, 1976; and
- REASONS: traditionally, the second Sunday in October has been set aside as a remembrance day for grandmothers;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim Sunday, October 10, 1976 to be

NATIONAL GRANDMOTHERS' DAY

Minnesota, and urge all citizens to join in this observance and pay tribute to those grand ladies who enjoy the happy state of grandmotherhood.
