Proclamation

EAS: Major General William S. Lundberg, who has served the State of Minnesota with distinction for forty-two years, began his military career with the Minnesota National Guard on October 13, 1934; and

EAS: he was called to active duty as a corporal with Battery B, 125th Field Artillery in 1941, and subsequently participated in the campaigns of Naples-Foggia, Rome-Arno, Southern France, Central Europe, Rhineland, and Ardennes-Alsace; and

EAS: General Lundberg was released from active duty in December 1945 and rejoined the Minnesota National Guard; and

EAS: he was again called to active duty during the Korean conflict in 1951 and, as a Captain, served in the 3rd Infantry Division; and

EAS: following his return to the United States and the Minnesota ARNG, he has held a number of executive posts; and

EAS: the outstanding reputation enjoyed by the Minnesota Army National Guard is due in great part to the efforts of Major General William S. Lundberg, Commander of the 47th "Viking" Infantry Division; and

EAS: Major General Lundberg's decorations, awards and honors include the European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal, with six Campaign Stars; American Campaign Medal; World War II Victory Medal; Army Occupation Medal; Good Conduct Medal; American Defense Service Medal; Korean Service Medal with three Campaign Stars; United Nations Service Medal; National Defense Service Medal; Armed Forces Reserve Medal; Bronze Star Medal, with OLC; Minnesota Service Medal; Minnesota Medal for Merit;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim today, July 17, 1976 to be
