Proclamation

WHEREAS: Reynolds Aluminum Recycling Company is again this year a corporate sponsor of the Muscular Dystrophy Association; and

WHEREAS: Reynolds Aluminum Recycling Company provides a large portion of funds in support of the worldwide program of research on neuromuscular diseases sponsored by the Muscular Dystrophy Association; and

WHEREAS: Reynolds Aluminum Recycling Company urges groups and individuals to collect aluminum cans and other clean household aluminum, to turn the metal in at one of Reynolds thirteen collect points in Minnesota and to donate the fifteen cents per pound to the Muscular Dystrophy Association; and

WHEREAS: recycling an aluminum can takes 95 percent less energy than it takes to produce the original aluminum for that can; and

WHEREAS: this effort is a demonstration of goodwill by all participants in energy conservation;
